Background of SNVC:

The Spay Neuter Veterinary Clinic of the Sandhills (SNVC) is dedicated to reducing overpopulation and improving the quality of life for pets through high quality, high volume spay neuter (HQHVSN) and wellness services. SNVC of Fayetteville has performed over 88,000 surgeries since opening at the end of 2007. The clinic moved from Moore County to Cumberland County at the start of 2021 to allow for expansion into a state of the art 6700 sq foot facility. The move allows SNVC to add wellness and dental services which are in high demand. In addition to the stationary clinic, SNVC has a mobile surgery unit that is used to reach out into the more underserved areas of the community for both surgery and vaccination clinics. SNVC serves as a training site for veterinary student externs and frequently have graduate veterinarians visit to work on surgical skills as training others in HQHVSN is extremely important to the entire team at SNVC.

Summary of Position:

The Spay Neuter Veterinary Clinic of the Sandhills has recently expanded and is increasing services offered to include preventative veterinary care, dentals, heartworm treatments, and preanesthetic bloodwork, in addition to spay/ neuter surgeries. Due to the expansion, SNVC is looking to hire additional staff to meet the increased demands. The Registered Technician would be in charge of training new staff, overseeing the wellness program, and assisting Veterinarians in surgery both at the stationary clinic and on the mobile surgery unit.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Assisting with vaccine clinics and wellness visits
- Collecting samples and performing in house diagnostics
- Ensuring safe, effective and efficient medical processes from check in to discharge
- Assisting with pre-surgical medical screenings, patient inductions, surgical preparation and anesthesia monitoring
- Maintaining strict sterile environment for all surgeries
- Monitoring the health of all patients throughout the day
- Provide medical information to clients and answer questions as needed
- Assisting with post-surgery follow up at complimentary recheck appointments as needed
